NEW: Love of Reading and Children: to recognize an individual who demonstrates passion for sharing stories and literacy activities with children and enhances this through extended ideas and activities. The nominee will also have demonstrated exceptional caring and compassion to the children in their care. *To be awarded to an RECE, Assistant or volunteer currently working within our community including Six Nations and New Credit Reserves* **Sponsored by The Dey Family**

BACK BY POPULAR DEMAND: Children's Champion: This special award will focus on individuals whose work has enhanced the lives of young children, but does not need to be a Registered ECE. Volunteers, recreational leaders, librarians, health care providers, teachers, home care providers, foster parents, child care cooks or any person who has demonstrated involvement for the greater good of children. *Must have had direct involvement in Brant or the Six Nations or Mississauga's of the New Credit Reserves, but may be retired.* **Sponsored by the Y Child Care System**

Rising Star Student Champion "To recognize a student in the field of Early Childhood Education that embodies the professional image and values of an early childhood educator through their actions and character. This is demonstrated through their leadership, volunteer work and relationships with children, peers and families. The student champion stands out above the rest and is perceived as a leader, motivator and advocate by others in the field. *To be awarded to a student who has done a local placement with children, from any post secondary institution.* **Sponsored by the OEYC Brant**

Making Every Kid Matter: "to recognize a dedicated RECE working in Brant County, Six Nations or Mississauga's of the New Credit Reserves who demonstrates exemplary, inclusive practices including embracing All children with varying abilities; creatively providing an environment to support the diverse needs of ALL children; promoting inclusive practices and pursuing continued learning opportunities to nurture and develop their own talents and skills." **Sponsored by Lansdowne Children's Centre**

Mohawk College ECE Alumni Award: "This recognizes an alumnus of the Early Childhood Education program at Mohawk College who believes in the value of quality care and has demonstrated their passion through sustained contributions and continued commitment to the field of ECE, including front-line work, supervisory responsibilities, and committee involvement. Must currently work in the Brant County, The Mississauga's of the New Credit First Nation, or Six Nations of the Grand River Reserve **Sponsored by Mohawk College**

Mohawk College Life Long Learner Award: "Recognizes an Early Childhood Educator who demonstrates qualities of a lifelong learner to include: supporting ECE students in the field through capacity building and mentoring; responding to current educational trends in society; committing to additional informal and formal learning opportunities above the DNA requirements; provides effective leadership and professionalism while working, currently, within Brant County, The Mississauga's of the New Credit First Nation, or Six Nations of the Grand River." **Sponsored by Mohawk College**

30 Year Life Time Achievement Award: To be presented to an RECE or equivalent who has worked in the early learning field for a minimum of 30 years. *Some of this time must have been spent in Brant, the Six Nations or Mississauga's of the New Credit but they may be currently retired. NEW in 2011*

Life Time Achievement Pin (For RECE's) will be presented to individuals who have a minimum of 20 years experience working in Early Childhood Education. Must currently hold a diploma in ECE (or equivalency) but may be retired. Individuals who have worked within the Brant community or on the Six Nations or Mississauga's of the New Credit Reserves some time during their career are eligible.

Lifetime Service to Children Pin: will be presented to individuals who have a minimum of 20 years of involvement with young children in the Brant Community or on the Six Nations of the Mississauga's Reserves. This is open but not limited to child care workers, educational assistants, home child care providers, foster parents, children's librarians, child welfare professionals, recreational workers, volunteers, or individuals who have worked for children on boards, committees etc. *May be retired.*
